What Do You Have to Lose?

- the Answer Is... Missing out on our full share of God's Harvest
- You are Perfect through Christ.
- Stop diminishing Perfection by Adding to it!

Giving thanks to the Father, who has enabled you to share in the saints' inheritance in the light. (1:12)

The gospel that has come to you. It is <u>bearing fruit</u> and growing all over the world, just as it has among you since the day you heard it and came to truly appreciate God's grace. (1:5b-6)

So that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: <u>bearing fruit</u> in every good work and growing in the knowledge of God. (1:10)

The Means of the Harvest – The Farmer is God

He has <u>rescued</u> us from the domain of darkness and <u>transferred</u> us into the kingdom of the Son he loves. In him we have <u>redemption</u>, the forgiveness of sins. (1:13-14)

Redemption = Rescue + Transfer

The Internal Harvest – The Difference God Can Make In You

For we have heard of your <u>faith</u> in Christ Jesus and of the <u>love</u> you have for all the saints 5 because of the <u>hope</u> reserved for you in heaven. You have already heard about this hope in the word of truth, the gospel. (1:4-5)

- Faith: Living in Close Contact with Limitless Being
- Love: Finding True Joy by Investing in Others
- Hope: Living For More than This Life

The External Harvest – The Difference God Can Make Through You

So that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the knowledge of God. (1:10)
